About college:

G.H. Rasoni College of Engineering (GHRCE) Nagpur, established in 1996, is an Empowered autonomous institution affiliated to Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University. The institute became Autonomous in 2010 and UGC has renewed autonomous status till 2032. It has been awarded A++ (3.55/4) grade by NAAC during 3rd cycle in 2023. It is ranked in the band of 151-200 in year 2023 PAN India in Engineering discipline and 51-100 in innovation Category, as declared by National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2023, MHRD, Government of India.

GHRCE's Institution Innovation Council ranked in 4 Star Top Performer as declared by Ministry of Education and MHRD Government of India in 2022. GHRCE ranked 27th in India level and 3rd in State level by Indian Institutional Ranking Framework (IIRF) under top private Engineering colleges in India 2023. GHRCE received Sustainable Institutions of India- Green Institutional Ranking 2023 in the "Gold Band" with Grade "A". GHRCE received the Institution of Engineers Engineering Education Excellence Award at the hands of Dr. K. Ponmudy, Hon'ble Minister for Higher Education, Govt. of Tamilnadu at Chennai. GHRCE received Paryavaran Sathi Award at World Environment Day Celebration in the Institution of Engineers, Nagpur Local Chapter.

The institute has brought many reforms under Autonomy, which prominently includes strengthening engagements with industries, implementation of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Credit Transfer Scheme (CTS) with VJTI Mumbai, IIIT Hyderabad, CoEP Pune, IIIT, Nagpur, IIT Bhilai and IIT Gandhinagar. GHRCE is nodal center of ISRO- IIRS (Indian Institute Remote Sensing).

GHRCE offers 13 Undergraduate, 8 Postgraduate in Engineering, 1 MBA and 5 Doctoral programmes. Two UG Programmes have completed four cycles, four UG Programmes have completed three cycles while one UG programme has completed two cycles of NBA accreditation. Three PG programmes have completed two cycles while six PG programmes have completed one cycle of accreditation by NBA. GHRCE has received R & D grants worth Rs. 35 Crores plus for research projects from prestigious government organizations such as AICTE/DST/UGC etc in addition to many seminar grants, travel grants, EDP grants, TEQIP-I, TEQIP-II projects of MHRD, AICTE-Digital Classroom, AICTE-UKIERI, ATAL FDP, AICTE-Margadarshan for mentoring 10 institutes, Margadarshak, UGC Paramarsh, NIDHI TBI from DST, PRERNA Scheme of AICTE for Higher studies, AICTE Samridhhi Startup program, Skill and Personality Development Programme Centre for SC/ST Students, TBI Funding for winner of Smart India Hackathon (Hardware Category), AICTE-Spices, Professional society IEEE, AICTE Youth Undertaking Visit for Acquiring Knowledge (Yuvak) Scheme, Mentor mentee scheme of Ministry of Education's Innovation cell, Department of Biotechnology (DBT) for organizing workshop, Mentor Mentee scheme of AICTE and ministry of Education, RGSTC, YUKTI 2.0 of Ministry of Education implemented by IIT Delhi, AICTE KARMA scheme, NAAC Scheme for organizing workshop on DVV, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Scheme, AICTE -MOE,IIC, AICTE Training & Learning (ATAL) Academy Hybrid FDP's, Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, AICTE IDEA LAB, IEEE-FDP, ISHRAE Student project Grant –Under Graduate, DST- TDP, Inter-University Centre for Astronomy and Astrophysics (IUCAA), BIRAC E YUVA .

It has been ranked under Platinum category for Best Industry linked institution by AICTE-CII Survey since last five years. The Institute has conducted 92 plus STTPs in-house in association with industries. Many leading MNCs like Mahindra & Mahindra, Intel, Cranes, Texas Instruments, Xilinx and National Instruments have established their laboratories on GHRCE campus.

It has hosted twenty five International Conferences amongst which Twelve IEEE, one Elsevier, three Springer, one Thomson Reuter, three ISBN, one AIP, three IOP and 34 National conferences. Experts from NITs, IITs, IISc and other reputed organizations are involved for assessing progress of Ph.D. students, PhD pre-submission and PhD colloquia.

The Institute has setup Incubation Centre funded by NSTEDB-DST Government of India, Innovation Cell and E-cell in the premises to create eco-system for entrepreneurship. It has organized 36 plus entrepreneurship events like Startup summit IGNITE, Entrepreneurship workshop. To make the students industry ready, the Institute has included 6 months mandatory industry internship in the 4 year B.Tech. course. Students undertook internship in 330 plus companies last year. The Institute has strong alumni network spread across the globe. Around 185 plus alumni are entrepreneurs since 2010. Students are National & International Color holders in various Sports. 100% projects are based on industrial problems.

In line with the Skill India campaign launched by Hon. Prime Minister of India, GHRCE in association with Yamaha Motors has started Yamaha Training School, which provides skill and competencies for two wheeler maintenance to under privileged youths with 100% assurance for Job.

We have center of excellence in BETiC, AI-ML, IOT, Smart City, Energy, Design, Signal processing, Information Security, Cloud Computing, High Performance Computing apart from Incubation, Pre-incubation, IPR Cell, Research Park. Center of Excellence in AI and ML has conducted successfully International AI Summit, National summit on Smart Solution to Smart Cities, MEDHA – Medical Devices Hackathon in association with IITB, VNIT, AIIMS, DMIMS.

The institute has Internship, Startup, Innovation, R&D Policy in place. The eco-system set for innovation has helped students to win many prizes at National level like Circular Economy Campaign 2023, DIPEX 2023, Global Student Entrepreneur Award with the cash money 50000/- for the Startup Player Orbit, CRCS competition with the prize money of 50000/-, AICTE Smart India Hackathon (Software Edition) in 2022. Students are in world finalists for Microsoft's Imagine Cup 2022, National level Go kart Event Auto India Racing Championship 2022. Student received Appreciation letter from Huawei for his outstanding work in the field of Information Security.

Our students are recognized by industries by way of Google student Ambassador, Microsoft students' partner, TCS campus Ambassador, etc. In line with 'Make in India' initiative, institute has filed 327 patents out of which 276 are published and 225 are under examination, 38 granted apart from 12 international patents in last 5 years.

The institution has an Internal Quality Assurance Cell [IQAC] that takes care of all academic activities on campus. Internal and external academic audits are a part of the institutional system along with a formal 360 degrees feedback system from all stakeholders for continuous improvement.


Introduction:

Institute has formulated Code of Conduct to improve overall development of students and teachers by creating effective teaching–learning atmosphere. It promotes the professional behavior and academic integrity. The reputation of institute depends on the academic performance as well as on behavior of the students. **Our Motto is "Self Discipline is the Best Discipline"**. The purpose of this code of conduct is to make the Students, Teachers, Departments, Cells & Committees familiar about the rules and regulations of the College and to progress towards the achievement of the mission and vision of the College.

All students are expected to observe rules and regulations to enable the smooth working of the college and keep Harmony, Silence and Educational Atmosphere in the College premises. The following code of conduct must be followed by every student of the college.

1. Classes will start from 9.30 a.m. and may continue up to 5.30 p.m. on all the six days of a week.
2. No student shall leave the premises before the college timing without the prior permission of HOD/class teacher.
3. As per RTMNU University, rules 75% attendance is mandatory to appear in semester end examination.
4. Every student of the college must always wear the valid Identity Card issued by the college with their recent photograph affixed, around the neck.
5. Students should greet the lecturers when they see them/across them for the first in a day, in the college time.
6. Only urgent/important notice shall be read out in classroom. Students should see the notice board daily and keep themselves well informed about the various notices that may be put up there from time to time.
7. Students must adhere to the Dress Code of the College. College dress should be neat and tidy.
8. College gives relaxation of uniform to the students on **Saturday** only for washing their regular college Uniform. But on **Saturday**, every student must avoid exaggerated fashions. (Girl students have to wear the formal/casual dress as like as the uniform of the college. Any types of western cultured dress strictly prohibited)
9. **No student allows**, keeping fashionable/cool/unusual/colored hair style.
10. Eatables snacks / beverages (drinks) are **not allowed** inside the College.
11. Ragging is an offence. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college campus/premises. Any student/students involved in such activities will be immediately expelled from the college.
12. If any student/students is/are affected by the ragging in the college premises or outside of the college, He/She/They must inform immediately to the Principal/Discipline & Ragging committee Coordinator.
13. Consuming Alcohol, Guthkha and Smoking is Strictly Prohibited in the Premises and Out of the College.
14. Every student help to keep college premises/campus/Class Room & desk- chairs clean and neat, everyone must use dust bin for garbage.
15. No student spite in college premises/campus or in class room.

16. College premises and all class rooms are under CCTV surveillance, everyone must follow the disciplinary manners in college premises/campus/class room.
17. During the conduct of lectures, Students should not loiter in and around the College premises.
18. Any student who damages the reputation of the college in any way is liable to be expelled. Offenders shall be liable to face legal action
19. Use of mobile phones in the classrooms, Library, area etc. is strictly prohibited.
20. No friends/ guests / visitors/any outsider shall be allowed with the students in the college premises/campus as well as in class room.
21. For any kind of misbehavior with teachers / administrative staff or creating disturbances in the college premises/ in classroom by a student or group of students, will lead to disciplinary action against him/her/them.
22. Students must conserve electricity and water. They must switch off lights & fans when they leave the class room, study room of library & computer lab.
23. Furniture in the class rooms should not be moved or displaced
24. Students must take proper care of all the college property. Any damage done to the property of the college by disfiguring walls, doors, windows, fittings, furniture and such other things is breach of discipline of the college and will be considered a punishable offence. Writing on walls, pillars, bath rooms, and furniture or White boards is strictly prohibited.
25. In case of continued poor performance in internal tests and poor class attendance of a student, the Director has the authority to withhold permission for him/her to appear the End Semester Examinations of the Institute.
26. Students will not be allowed to celebrate any function /program in the college campus / class room without prior permission of the Director of the Institute.
27. Any student who damages the reputation of the college in any way is liable to be expelled. Offenders shall be liable to face legal action
28. Any type of malpractice is strictly prohibited in Unit Test/ College Examinations.
29. Celebration of any western cultured day (like friendship day/Valentine Day) by the students in college premises is strictly prohibited.
30. Students are prohibited from doing anything inside or outside the College which will affect its public image. No outside influence, political or any other should be brought in to the college directly or indirectly.
31. In case of any kind of problem or need of medical emergency in the college student should report to the HOD/concern teacher, who will help them solve their problem.
32. Each student should park his/her vehicle at the parking of the college.
33. No student are not allowed in college premises without HELMET. Students must wear helmet while riding two wheeler.
34. A student shall not knowingly provide false information or make misrepresentation to any College office. In addition, the forgery, alteration, or unauthorized possession or use of College documents, records, or instruments of identification, forged or fraudulent communications (paper or electronic mail) are prohibited
