

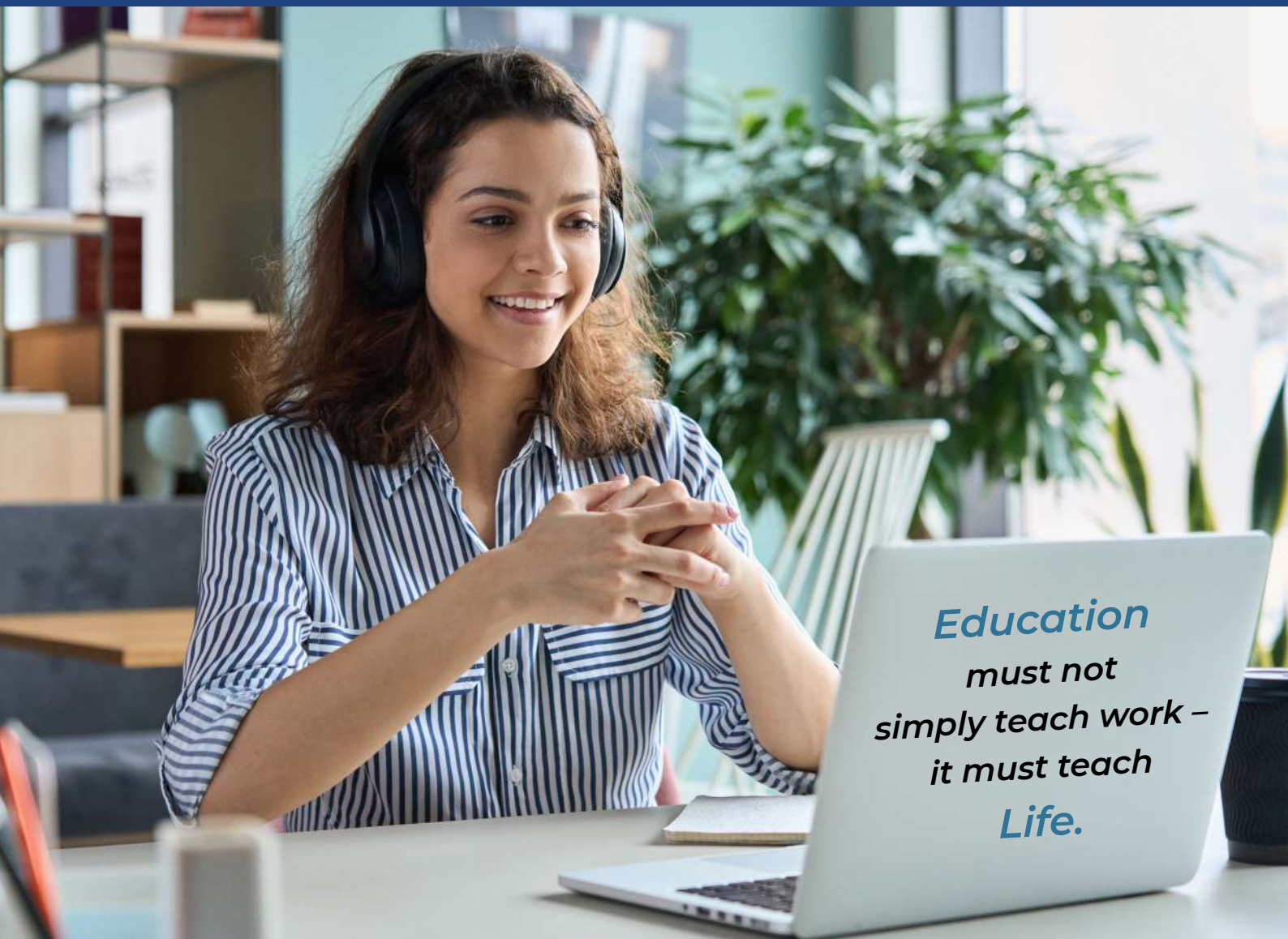

This competition was different from the regular hackathons that focused on the conversion of ideas into prototypes. In addition, Hackathons do not focus on parameters like cost efficiency, validation of ideas, scope of product, perspective customers, impact of the product on the environment, etc.

In this competition, ideas were floated in consultation with industry experts in various domains like IoT, AI, AIML, Drones, Block Chain, Cloud Computing, Electric Vehicles, Cyber security, robotics, and Robotics and Others.

The participating team had to choose any one idea from a specific domain & evaluate the feasibility of that idea on the basis of 10 parameters communicated to them as an idea validation matrix.

The idea validation matrix consisted of 10 parameters: novelty of idea, Utility, Feasibility, Design & Development, Cost Effectiveness, Possible Patentability, Social & Environmental Impact, Business Model & Beneficiaries, Futuristic Perspective, and Special Government Schemes for this idea.

121 teams with 700+ students participated.

In the First round, the uploaded idea validation matrices were shortlisted by senior faculty and HoDs of the respective branches. In the second

round, the selected idea- validation matrix was then sent to external evaluators, Mr. Mayuresh Kulkarni (Startup Incubation Manager) and Vinayak (Data Scientist at iKnowlation Research Labs), for evaluation as per rubrics.

The final round consisted of a PPT presentation by the selected teams to a different set of evaluators, Mr. Ashwin Balani (CEO, First Impression Technologies), and Dr. K. C. Vora (former Sr. Dy. Director, ARAI, Pune, and Professor of Practice at GHRCEM, Pune).
