

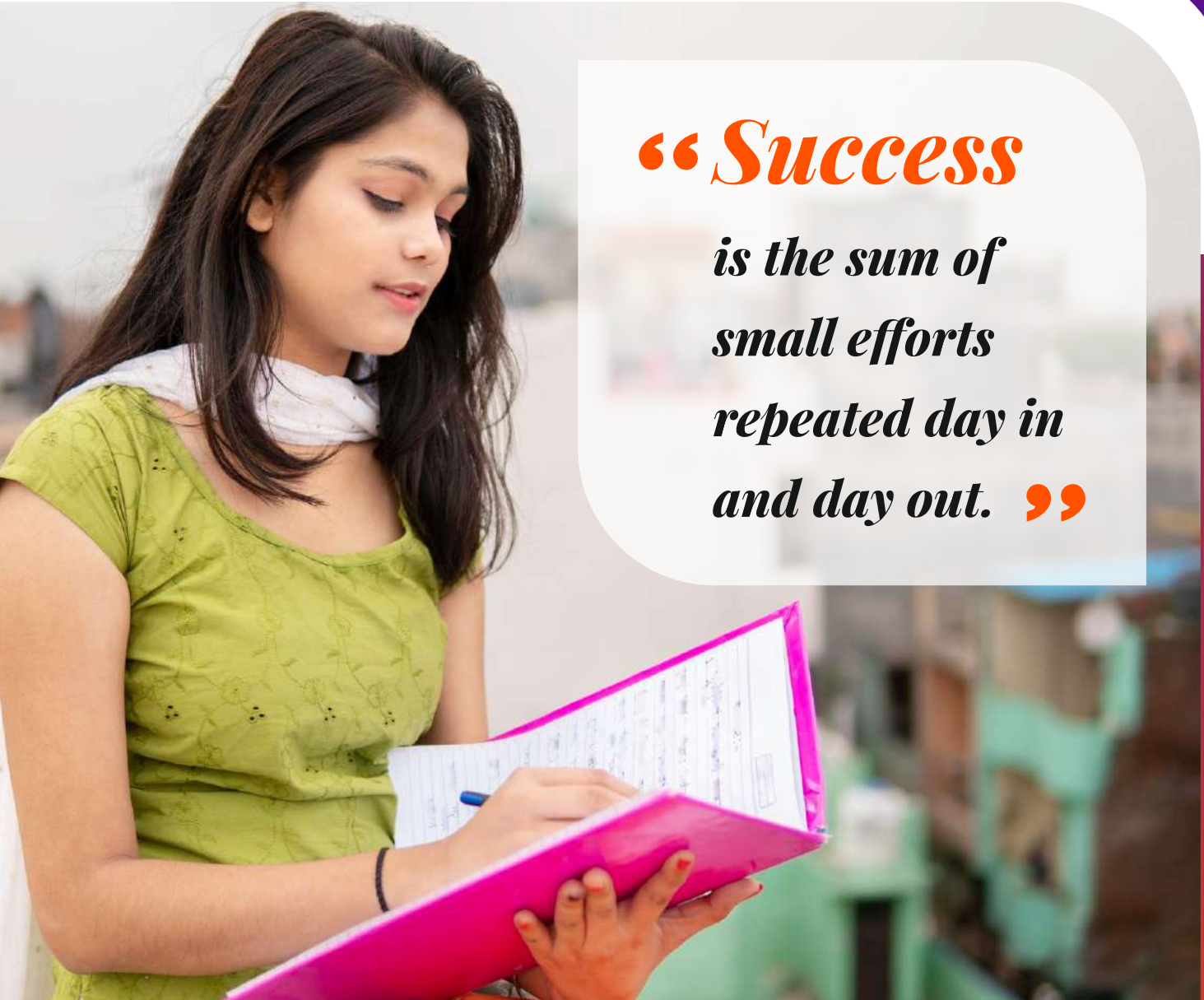

## GHRCEM, Jalgaon Organised Tiffin Box Distribution

Distribution Project was successfully organized by the Rotaract Club of Rasoni, Jalgaon at Raj Madhyamik School, Mehrun, Jalgaon, with the core objective of promoting nutrition, hygiene, and healthy eating habits among school students. The initiative was designed as a meaningful step towards improving the overall well-being of children by addressing one of the most fundamental needs—access to safe and healthy meals. In today's fast-paced environment, many students from economically and socially challenged backgrounds often attend school without proper lunch arrangements. This lack of nutritious food not only affects their physical health but also significantly impacts their concentration, energy levels, and academic performance. Recognizing this concern, the Rotaract Club undertook this project with the belief that small, thoughtful interventions can create a lasting positive impact on young lives. As part of the project, a total of 183 tiffin boxes were distributed to students of Raj Madhyamik School. These tiffin boxes were provided with the intention of encouraging students to carry home-cooked meals, thereby fostering healthy eating habits and reducing their dependence on unhygienic and unhealthy street food. The initiative also aimed to instill a sense of responsibility and routine among students regarding their daily meals. A key highlight of this project was that the entire expenditure for the tiffin boxes was collectively contributed by the Rotaractors themselves. Every Rotaractor willingly participated in fundraising and contribution efforts, reflecting the club's strong spirit of

selfless service, teamwork, and social responsibility. This collective financial contribution ensured that the project remained fully student-driven, reinforcing the values of leadership, accountability, and empathy among club members. The planning and execution of the project involved multiple stages, including need assessment, coordination with school authorities, budgeting, procurement, and final distribution. Prior permission and cooperation were obtained from the school management, who welcomed the initiative and extended full support. Teachers and staff members appreciated the Rotaract Club's efforts and acknowledged the positive impact such initiatives have on students' daily routines. On the day of distribution, Rotaractors interacted directly with the students, explaining the importance of bringing nutritious food from home, maintaining cleanliness of lunch boxes, and avoiding junk food. These interactions helped create awareness among students in an engaging and friendly manner.

The smiles and excitement on the faces of the children during the distribution served as a powerful reminder of the importance of community-driven service initiatives. Beyond providing physical resources, the project also focused on promoting hygiene practices. Students were encouraged to keep their tiffin boxes clean, wash them regularly, and practice basic personal hygiene. Such awareness is essential in preventing health issues and fostering lifelong healthy habits from a young age. The project aligns strongly with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs),



particularly SDG 2 (Zero Hunger), SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-being), and SDG 4 (Quality Education). By ensuring students have access to proper meals, the initiative indirectly supports better learning outcomes and overall development. The Tiffin Box Distribution Project also served as an important learning experience for the Rotaractors. It enhanced their organizational, leadership, and communication skills while reinforcing the importance of social sensitivity. Contributing financially and actively participating in the execution allowed Rotaractors to understand the value of shared responsibility and community engagement. Feedback received from the school authorities was extremely positive.

Teachers observed that students felt motivated and valued, which can contribute to increased school attendance and attentiveness in

classrooms. Parents were also indirectly encouraged to provide regular home-packed meals for their children, thereby extending the impact of the project beyond the school premises. In conclusion, the Tiffin Box Distribution Project was a successful and impactful initiative by the Rotaract Club of Raisoni, Jalgaon. Through collective effort, personal contributions, and dedicated execution, the club was able to make a meaningful difference in the lives of 183 students. The project stands as a testament to the power of youth-led initiatives in addressing real societal challenges and promoting sustainable change. The Rotaract Club remains committed to undertaking more such projects in the future, continuing its mission of service above self and working towards building a healthier, more inclusive society.

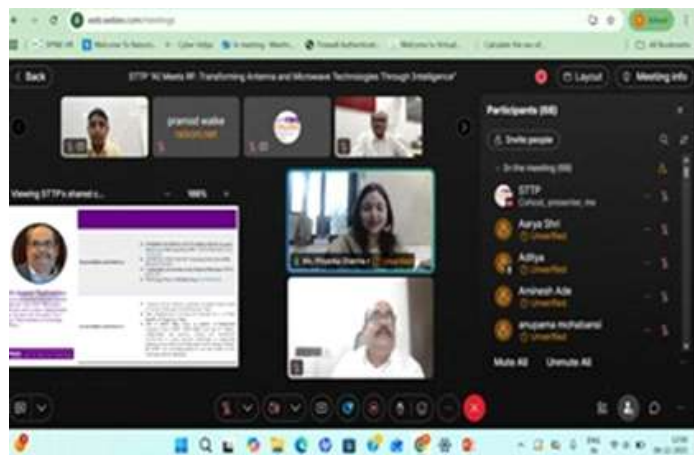
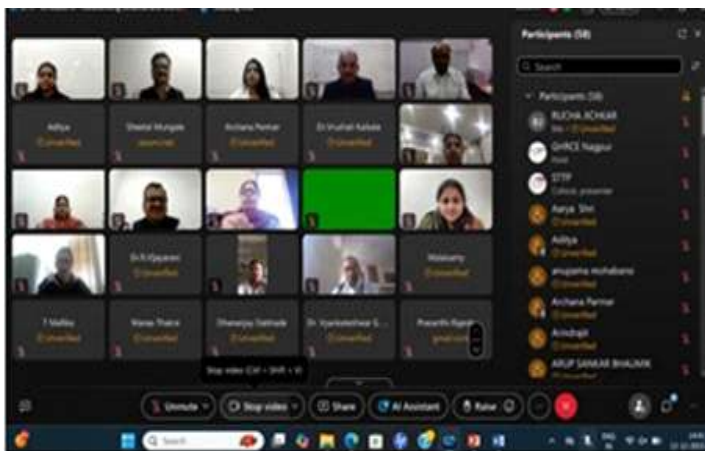
### One Week Online STTP on “AI Meets RF Transforming Antenna and Microwave Technologies Through Intelligence”

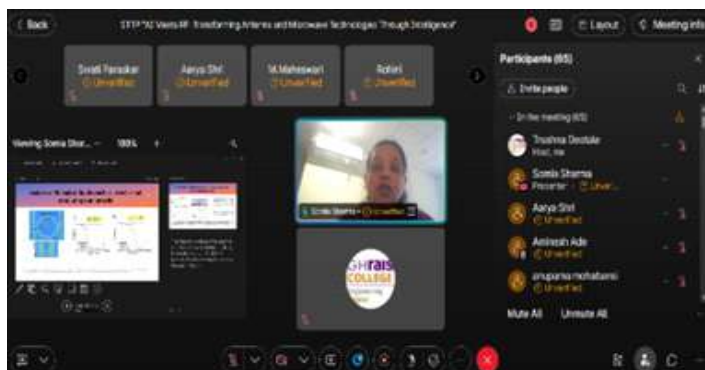

faculty understanding in the field of Intellectual Property Rights and to facilitate the research culture by introducing the fundamentals of patent, copyright, and the structured patent filing process. The session was held in A-1-06, Block A, Dept. of MCA and was attended by the

all the faculties of BCA and MCA Department GHRCEM and GHRSTU. Dr. Himanshu Sharma, Dean of Research & Development and Associate Professor at GHRCEM, Nagpur, was the Resource Person and Guest Speaker for this session. Dr. Sharma gave an elaborate presentation on the kinds of IPRs, emphasizing the importance of patents, copyrights, trademarks, and industrial designs. He explained the key Patentability Parameters, Novelty, Inventive Step, Industrial Applicability, and Usefulness supported by real-time examples relevant to academic and technical fields. He further discussed the complete patent filing lifecycle, including:

- Identification of the problem statement
- Drafting the specification
- Filing and publication
- Request for Examination (RFE)
- Hearing process
- Grant of patent
- Pathway toward commercialization

The copyright procedures were also examined in detail, with a focus on protection for academic content, software programs, digital resources, and research publications. Dr. Sharma further explained the reimbursement and documentation involved in patent filing, thus bringing more clarity and confidence to the faculty members about engaging themselves in IPR activities. The seminar was initiated and encouraged by Prof. Anupam Chaube, Dean–Science & Technology, GHRCEM. It was conducted under the guidance of Dr. Sandhya Dahake, Head of the MCA Department. In her opening remarks, Dr. Dahake encouraged the faculty members to move ahead with professional development in addition to routine academic responsibilities

and motivated them to file or publish at least one patent in the forthcoming quarter. Continuing the same vision, Dr. Rajani D. Singh, R&D Coordinator for GHRCEM and GHRSTU, highlighted current trends, national surveys, and the growing demand for Intellectual Property Rights. She presented a concise summary of the session and emphasized the importance of innovation-driven academic practices. 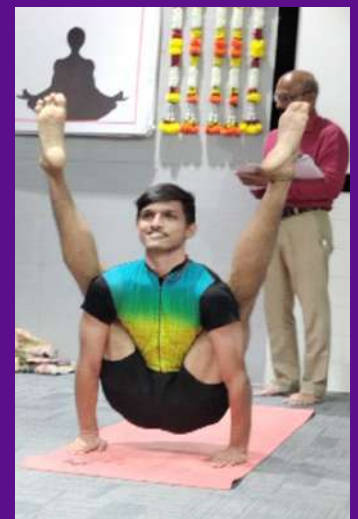
## GHRCE Student Shubham Rai Helps RTMNU Qualify for Khelo India University Games Through Yoga
