"Implantable Bone lengthening Nail" Developed at BETiC-GHRCE in association with Raycura Medical Technologies, Nagpur

Two enterprising young interns of the Biomedical Center of Excellence BETiC of G H Raison College of Engineering, Nagpur, Mr. Rohan Deshpande and Mr. Ayush Gaikwad with clinician Dr. Sushil Mankar, Orthopaedic Surgeon, Lata Mangeshkar Hospital Nagpur under the guidance of Dr. Vibha Bora, Incharge BETiC and Prof. Suraj Dudhe, had designed Implantable Bone lengthening Nail. They founded a startup named 'Raycura,' dedicated to producing limb-lengthening implants that offer innovative solutions for bone defects and regeneration. Drawing on their mechanical engineering background, these ambitious entrepreneurs have introduced a groundbreaking alternative to the conventional Ilizarov frame from Russia, which doctors typically use to address bone-related issues resulting from accidents or bone infections.

Traditionally, patients undergoing treatment with the Ilizarov frame are required to bear the weight of a cumbersome three-kilogram frame within their bodies for approximately one and a half years. This procedure, while effective, is excruciatingly painful for the patients. Rohan and Ayush have designed an innovative and pain-free solution in the form of implantable limb lengthening rods. They emphasize that by utilizing these lightweight rods during the bone lengthening treatment process, patients no longer need to endure the agony previously associated with this therapy. Furthermore, this

pioneering approach involves the utilization of locally manufactured equipment, reducing the dependence on foreign brands & subsequently lowering costs for the patients. This journey began in 2019 and in May 2023 these two interns received BIRAC BIG grant of Rs.50 Lakh for development of the same from Govt of India. They had also filed patent.

Remarkably, the implantable rod developed by Raycura offers the convenience of wireless control, making the treatment process even more patient-friendly. Rohan and Ayush express their conviction that this innovative startup will revolutionize bone lengthening treatment, making it not only highly effective but also remarkably comfortable. They extend their



gratitude to Director Dr. Sachin Untawale, Dr. Sushil Mankar, Dr. Vibha Bora, Dr. Rupesh Shelke, Prof. Suraj Dudhe and the supportive

R&D faculty, for their invaluable assistance and support in bringing this remarkable endeavour to fruition.

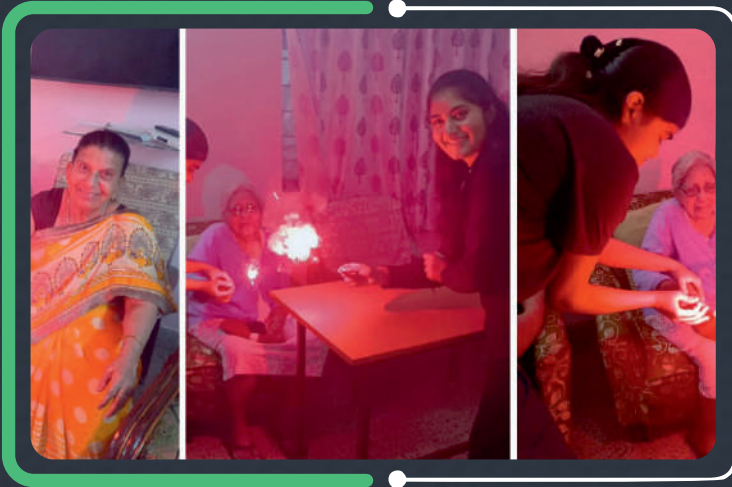

Diwali Celebration by SRWC, Nagpur at Old Age Home

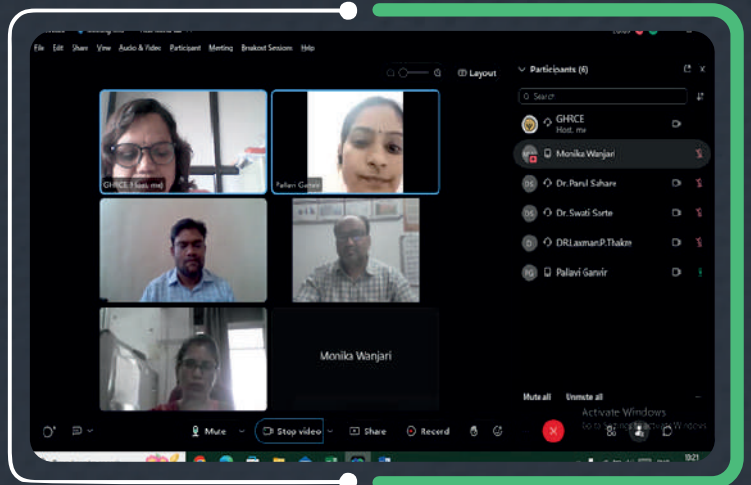

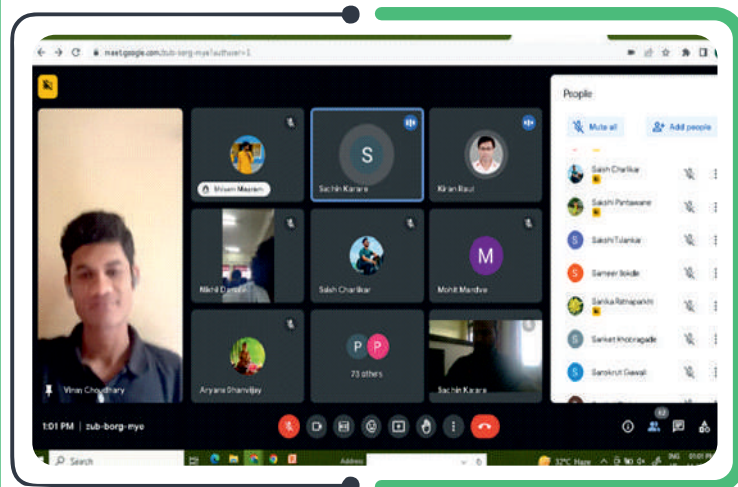
Students - Alumni Interaction Organized at GHRIET, Nagpur

Students of university are looking forward to add charity as a part of their professional life.

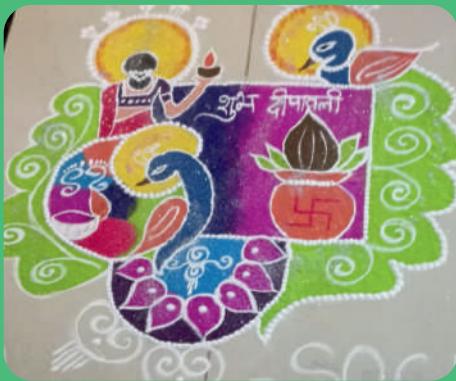

4. Understand where to publish the research.

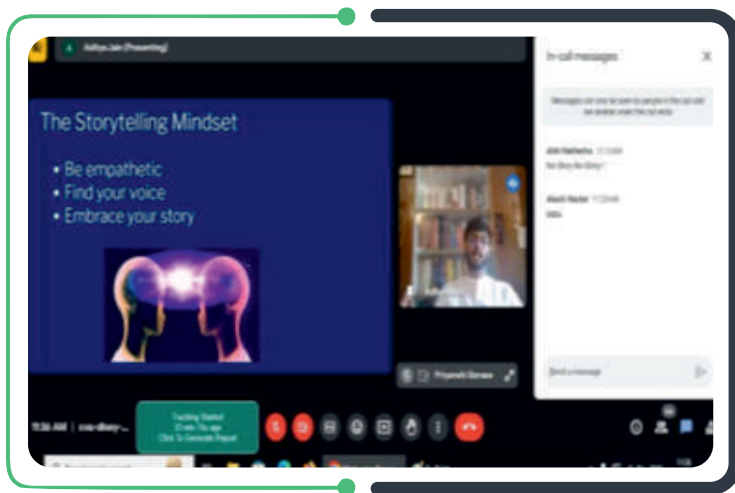
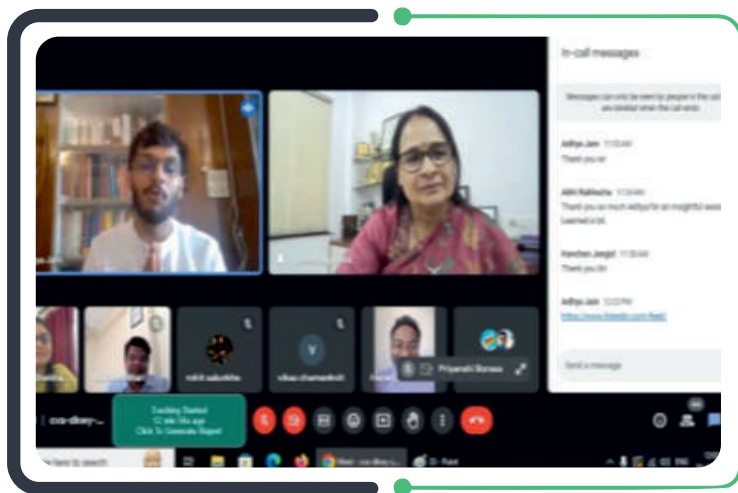


Session on “Power of Storytelling” Conducted at GHRIEBM, Jalgaon

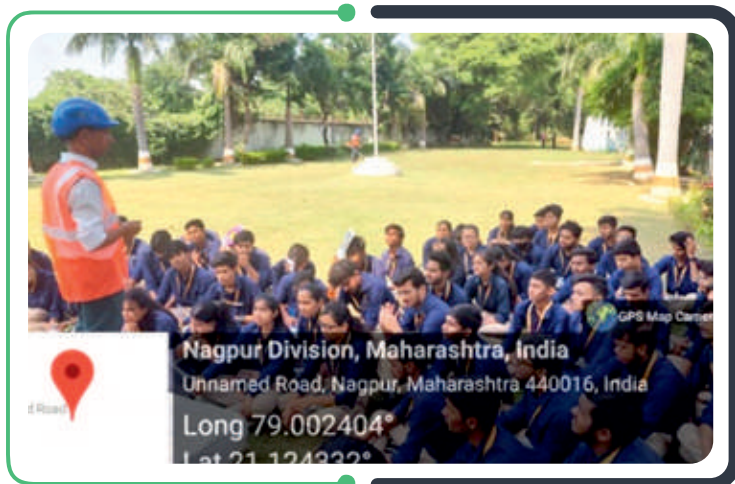
Industrial Visit
